Photo Contest Rules

1. Eligibility – The contest is open to anyone who resides in the Stories of the Chesapeake Heritage Area which encompasses Caroline, Kent, Queen Anne’s and Talbot Counties. Members of the Eastern Shore Heritage, Inc. Board of Directors and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in the photo contest.
2. Locale – All vintage photographs must have been taken within the Stories of the Chesapeake Heritage Area. A map of the heritage area may be found at www.storiesofthechesapeake.org
3. Deadline – All entries must be postmarked by August 1, 2017.

5. Entry Forms – Entries must be accompanied by a completed and signed Entry Form. The form is printable from www.storiesofthechesapeake.org
6. Multiple Entries – A maximum of ten (10) vintage photographs per entrant is allowed. All entries must be listed on a single Entry Form.
7. Entry Fee – An entry fee of \$10 shall accompany each submission. A submission may include up to four vintage photographs. A one year membership in the Eastern Shore Heritage, Inc., which is the managing entity of the Stories of the Chesapeake Heritage Area, is included with each \$10 entry fee.
8. Format – Entries may be either prints or prints with digital images.

Print Entries: The prints will be used for judging. 4”x6” or 5”x7” prints are recommended. Clearly label on the back of the printed image with: the photographer’s name, if known; title of photograph; location where photograph was taken; and a brief statement of the story the photograph tells.

Digital Entries: Photographs must be submitted in jpeg, jpg, or gif format. Clearly label the disk with: the photographer’s name, title of photograph; location where photograph was taken; and a brief statement of the story the photograph tells.

9. Model Release – A photographers/model release must accompany all entries. Photos containing recognizable people must be accompanied by the model release form, available at www.storiesofthechesapeake.org, signed by the photographer or photographer's heirs and by the subject of the photo or the subject's heirs.
10. Judging – Entries will be judged on the basis of photographic quality and the effectiveness in conveying the message of the distinctive character of the heritage area. A panel selected by the Eastern Shore Heritage Inc. Board of Directors will judge the entries. Honorable mentions will be awarded at the discretion of the judges. Winners will be announced at the Stories of the Chesapeake Fall Event.
11. Winning Photos – The winning photographs will with appropriate credit appear in the Stories of the Chesapeake Heritage Area 2014 Calendar.
12. Photographers Rights – Each entrant will retain rights to any photograph submitted – including ownership, other than those rights licensed in the next sentence. By entering the contest, each entrant hereby grants to the Stories of the Chesapeake Heritage Area (1) an exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable, royalty-free license to reproduce, distribute, publically display the photographs submitted and (2) the right to use the entrants name, city and state of residence in promotions and other publications. All entries must be accompanied by the release signed by the photographer or photographers heirs.
13. Other – Photographs, regardless of medium, will not be returned. Do not send your only copy of a photograph. Copies of photographs at Edwards Pharmacy in Centreville , Ship and Print Place in Easton, or at the Finishing Touch in Chestertown for a nominal charge. Eastern Shore Heritage, Inc. and the Stories of the Chesapeake Heritage Area are not responsible for any material lost, damaged, or misdirected in the mail.
